Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your contact details and demographic information • Social Security number and account transactions • Credit history and credit scores • Transaction history and credit products rates and payments 	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons LendingTree chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who we are

Who is providing this notice?

This privacy policy is being provided by LendingTree, LLC and other LendingTree companies with a LendingTree name, including QuoteWizard.com, LLC, Ovation Credit Services, Inc., ValuePenguin, Inc., etc. (collectively, "Lending Tree").

What we do

How does LendingTree protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

We use encryption in the transmittal of your sensitive personal information between your systems and ours and we use firewalls.

How does LendingTree collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- open an account
- initiate an application for a financial product or service, such as a loan

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes –information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Our affiliates include companies with a LendingTree name, including financial companies such as QuoteWizard.com, LLC, Ovation Credit Services, Inc., ValuePenguin, Inc., etc.

Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nonaffiliates we share with may include loan brokers, lenders, insurance companies and direct marketing companies
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our joint marketing partners may include lenders and other third parties that provide services to our consumers in our network.

VT: If you are consumer with a Vermont mailing address, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of LendingTree, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts or under joint marketing agreements with other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing agreements. We will not share information about your creditworthiness within our corporate family except with your consent, but we may share information about our transactions or experiences with you within our corporate family without your consent.

CA: If you are a consumer with a California mailing address, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of LendingTree, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts, or to provide rewards or benefits to which you are entitled.
